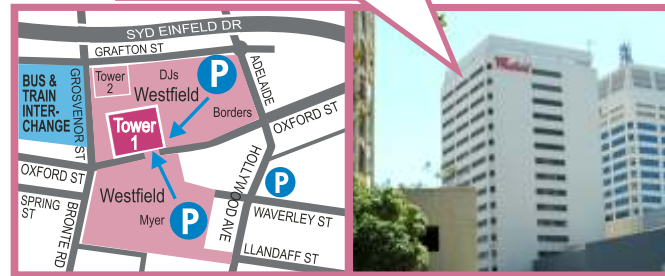

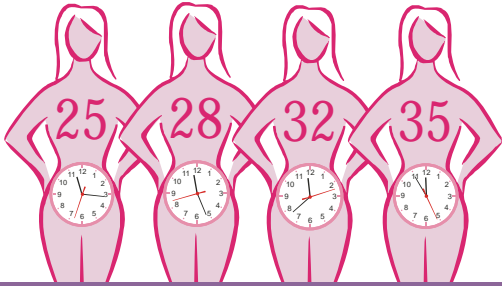

### *Cryopreservation of Oocytes*

This treatment involves the freezing and storage of Oocytes (Eggs) until you find a suitable partner. This technology is currently available with variable success rates. Success is affected by female age and other fertility issues if present. Cryopreservation is ideally suited to young females under 35, or even better under 30. Ongoing research is enabling us to continue to make improvements to the process.

### *Donor Sperm*

Donor options are available to a wider range of female patients. Fertility East has expanded its donor sperm program specifically to help and care for single females wishing to start a family. We currently have one of the largest donor programs in Australia and can offer our single patients a selection of choice with regards to donor sperm.

### *Donor embryos*

Some women may require this option, which should be discussed in more detail with your doctor.

## Our Donors

Fertility East has one of the largest donor programs in Australia specialising in providing donor gametes (sperm, eggs and embryos) to our patients. We maintain and continue to develop a donor sperm bank with Australian donors and have affiliations with US sperm banks offering a wide range of choices for our patients. All our donors meet the current health, legal, State and Federal legislation requirements.

Donors are subject to thorough medical, familial and genetic evaluation. The donor's family history is checked for potentially inheritable diseases. Further genetic tests may also be performed to exclude abnormalities such as cystic fibrosis.

All semen is kept in quarantine for six months and then retested for infectious diseases before being sanctioned. This means you can have peace of mind that your donor will be subject to the highest levels of screening.

Legal: Current NSW legislation (ART Act 2007) requires all donors to be listed on a donor register. A donor would be identifiable to the child when they reach 18 should they desire.

Under section 14 of the NSW Status of Children Act 1996, a semen donor is presumed not to be the legal father of any child born as a result of assisted reproduction using donor semen. This means that the donor will generally not be liable under the laws governing child support, inheritance and related issues. In most cases, the legal parents of the child will be the birth mother and her partner, if she has one. If you wish to obtain further information about this or any other legal issue associated with your donation, please seek legal advice.
